Hello! to all our old friends and a special welcome to our new stallholders.

Thank you for enquiring about booking a stall for the 2020 Doll Bear & Craft Fair. If you have any questions about the Fair please do not hesitate to contact us. Stalls for this year's fair are \$120 each.

A trestle table measuring approximately 180 cm x 75 cm and two chairs will be provided and are included in the price. Please note that extra tables, racks etc **MUST NOT** be placed next to your stall as they may encroach on other stallholders' space or walkways.

Any cancellation of stalls prior to 31ST July 2020 will incur a \$30.00 cancellation fee per stall. There is considerable paperwork and adjustments required with cancellations resulting in the necessity for this fee. There will be **NO REFUND** of payments made on stalls cancelled after this date. Stalls will be re-allocated to applicants on the waiting list after this date.

Just to let you know that we have made a few changes to next year's starting & finishing times. The Museum will be open on both days from 8am as usual for stall holders to set up, but the fair will open to the public from 9am instead of 9.30am. We have also changed the finishing times on both days till 3pm instead of 4pm. The reason is that the 4pm finish has become a safety issue on the Sunday as stall holders are tending to be packing up while we are still letting the public in the door. This year we had people leaving, putting boxes in isles and wheeling trolleys out while customers were still here. We find that this is not acceptable and as such are changing the finishing time till **3pm and no packing up is to take place prior to that time.**

Due to increased insurance and safety obligations, all aisles and areas accessible to the public must be kept clear at all times. All reasonable instructions issued by the Events Organiser or Safety Officer must be followed.
